- NUDE photography is excluded in this competition.
- · Color and Monochrome Must satisfy FIAP definitions .
- Decisions of Jury are FINAL.
- The catalogue will contain all accepted photos, and will be sent as PDF file to the provided Entrants' Emails.
- Awarded photos become a property of the Photographic Society of Oman with keeping authors rights.
- The organizers will have the right to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for non-commercial publication for promotional purposes and/or display in media related to the exhibition and in the catalogue.

"With the sole act of submitting his/her images or files to a salon under FIAP Patronage, the entrant accepts without exception and with no objection that the submitted images can be investigated by FIAP to establish if these obey to FIAP regulations and definitions even if the entrant is not a member of FIAP; that FIAP will use any means at its disposal for this undertaking; that any refusal to cooperate with FIAP or any refusal to submit the original files as captured by the camera, or failure to provide sufficient evidence, will be sanctioned by FIAP and that in case of sanctions following the non compliance with FIAP regulations, the name of the entrant will be released in any form useful to inform the breaches of the rules. It is recommended to leave the EXIF data in the submitted files intact in order to ease eventual investigations."



Entries:

- Entries Must originate as photographs (image-captures of objects via light sensitivity) and must be **entirely** the work of the entrant.
- · A maximum of four (4) Prints may be submitted in each section.

The same image must **NOT** be entered in more than one section.

- The print size excluding borders is (20 cm x 20 cm)
 - Prints larger or smaller than this size will be rejected and not judged.
 - Prints without borders are preferred .
- The back of each print must have a label containing (Author name, Country, section, image title) which correspond to the information written in the entry form. The orientation of the text in those labels will indicate the orientation of the print.
- (JPEG Copies required): You will need to submit CD of the entries in JPEG format to be used in producing the catalogue (1200 pixels for each side, 72 dpi)

Definitions:

· FIAP Definition of Monochrome Photography

A black and white work fitting from the very dark grey (black) to the very clear grey (white) is a monochrome work with the various shades of grey. A black and white work toned entirely in a single colour will remain a monochrome work able to stand in the black and white category. On the other hand a black and white work modified by a partial toning or by the addition of one colour becomes a colour work (polychrome) to stand in the colour category.

· FIAP Definition of Color Photography

Any photograph that is not monochrome. It includes a monochrome photograph that has been partially toned or had colour added.
